

## 「政制改革發展」講座

### *Seminar on Constitutional Development by the Hon. Carrie Lam*

為收集各界婦女就政制改革發展的意見，並提供一個讓婦女發表意見和交流的平台，本會很榮幸邀得政務司司長林鄭月娥女士和勞工及福利局局長張建宗先生在3月主講「政制改革發展」講座。

是次講座共吸引了百多人出席，參加者包括來自教育、法律、建築、醫學、會計、工商、環保等不同專業界別的女性代表，並於講座中踴躍發言。出席人士除了包括本會多位會長、理事及會員外，並有三十多個婦女團體代表以及多名青年領袖等參與。

林鄭月娥在講座上表示，如期落實2017年普選行政長官，是中央、特區政府和廣大香港市民的共同願望。特區政府會盡一切努力，促使社會各界凝聚共識。政府期望社會能在《基本法》和全國人大常委會相關解釋和決定的基礎上，就2017年行政長官及2016年立法會產生辦法相關的重點議題作充分討論，並呼籲各界能夠抱着理性和務實的態度，就兩套選舉辦法尋求共識，讓香港政制得以向前發展。

本會將繼續積極推動會員參與政制發展的討論，收集婦女團體及會員的意見，並向政府積極反映。

In order to gather different views on political reform and provide a platform to women for exchanging their views, another seminar was held on constitutional development in March by the Hon. Mrs. Carrie Lam, the Chief Secretary for Administration, and the Hon. Matthew Cheung, Secretary for Labour and Welfare.

The seminar was well received by over 100 participants. Female representatives from different professions and sectors exchanged their views on political reform at the seminar.

Carrie Lam stated that the Central Government, the HKSAR Government and the vast majority of Hong Kong people, are eager to see an election of Chief Executive by universal suffrage, while the HKSAR Government is making tireless and pragmatic efforts to achieve the goal of universal suffrage. The HKSAR Government will endeavour to seek a common ground and push forward Hong Kong's democratic development.

### *Submission of HKFW's proposal on constitutional development*

堅守有法必依，尊重法律的核心價值。因此，行政長官的產生辦法必須依據基本法和全國人大常委會的有關決定及解釋。基本法第45條明確地寫明：『行政長官的產生辦法根據香港特別行政區的實際情況和循序漸進的原則而規定，最終達至由一個有廣泛代表性的提名委員會按民主程序提名後普選產生』。

總括而言，本會期望各界能以求同存異、凝聚共識的原則，理性討論並提出具建設性及可行性的方案，令政制發展可以往前走。香港推行普選，必須符合法律之餘，又應從實際情況及現實角度出發，這才是最貼切香港的需要。

HKFW has conducted three seminars to encourage our members to express their views on political reform and constitutional development. On 2nd May, Chairperson Dr. Peggy Lam and our Executive Committee Members submitted the proposal on constitutional development to the Chief Secretary of Administration the Hon. Mrs. Carrie Lam. These represented the opinions collected from our members, corporate members and the suggestions made by the HKFW.

Dr. Lam stated that Rule of Law is among Hong Kong's one of the most important core values. Therefore, selection methods for the Chief Executive must be in compliance with the Basic Law and the Interpretation and Decisions of the Standing Committee of the National People's Congress. According to Article 45 of the Basic Law, "The method for selecting the Chief Executive shall be specified in the light of the actual situation in the HKSAR and in accordance with the principle of gradual and orderly progress. The ultimate aim is the selection of the Chief Executive by universal suffrage upon nomination by a broadly representative nominating committee in accordance with democratic procedures."

In conclusion, HKFW looks forward to seeing all sectors of the society working towards a common ground. And the community can widely discuss constitutional development and strive for a constructive and feasible proposal.
